

When to use TANOPLUS AR FRESH SPARKLING WINES[®] ?

At the fining or at prebottling phase The treated wines can be tasted the same day of the treatment, however it is recommended to wait at least 48 hours.

It is recommended to use TANOPLUS AR FRESH SPARKLING WINES at a dosage between 5 to 20 g/hl. The dosage, and therefore the treatment cost, can be optimised by doing direct trials in bottles at different concentrations.
